Fort Concho National Historic Landmark serves over 65,000 guests each year with programs, activities, special events, tours, and education programs. We do this with the help of a loyal and talented volunteer corps that assists us throughout the year. Most volunteer opportunities have flexible schedules, and training is provided by fort staff. Our Christmas at Old Fort Concho event (December) and Frontier Day (June) use hundreds of volunteers. Many other events require volunteer assistance.

Education/Living History

Volunteers serve as guides to greet visitors, and assist in educational programs. Our living history volunteers portray the soldiers and civilians of the 1870-1880s for special events, tours, and at out-of-town programs.

Collections
