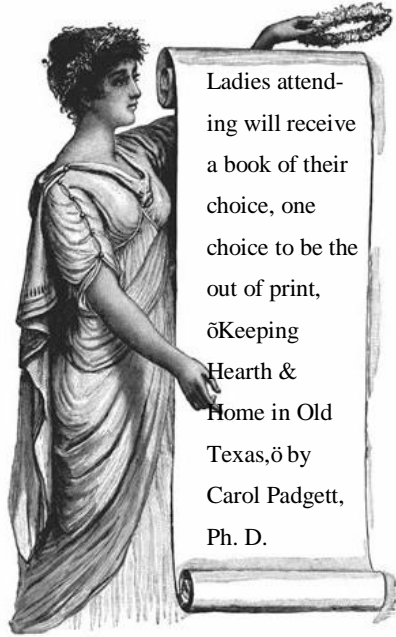


## School of the Victorian Lady

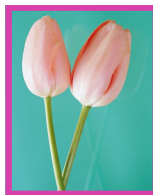
# School of the Victorian Lady-8th Conference
